Thursday, February 19th, 2026

The Meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Jessica Schrimpf. Mgrs. Cox led an opening prayer.

Members present: Tina Forbis (Principal), Mgrs. Cox (Pastor) Jessica Schrimpf (President), Travis Bruemmer, Megan Luebbert, Susan Beck, Sarah Bruemmer, Jessica Nicolaescu, Jennifer Wolken, and Andrea White.

A motion was made by Andrea White and seconded by Travis Bruemmer to approve the November minutes. The motion to approve carried.

Pastor's Report:

- Reconciliation will be offered for students.
- Confirmation is March 3rd. This will be the first visit from Bishop Ralph O'Donnell to St. Stanislaus. Twenty-nine 7th graders are getting confirmed.
- Twenty-five 2nd graders are making their First Communion on May 3rd.
- May 6th is mass for all 8th graders in the Jefferson City Diocese.

Principal's Report

- Updates have been made to security camera power supply and additional security cameras have been added.
- Enrollment began in January starting with preK continuing through February. -Letters of intent have been sent out to staff. Ms. Stumpe is retiring. There is a current opening for a Music teacher.
- Mrs. Forbis renewed her contract for Principal for 2026-2027.
- Catholic school week was a success.
- The field trip for Chris in the Classroom was rescheduled to March due to snow impacting travel on day of the field trip. Students will learn about resiliency and coping strategies.
- March 5th is early dismissal for students. The teachers will have meetings that day.
- March 6th is a teacher work day.
- The school supply company EPI reached out regarding ordering school supplies for students. Feedback was well received for this. Discussed options for offering this again next year. -Bus service option was discussed. Durham prices are too high and put too much financial risk on the school. Not planning on offering bus service for next school year 2026-2027. -A proposed calendar for 2026/2027 was reviewed. Discussed early dismissal days, start time and PD days to schedule within the year. Switching to 1:30 dismissals primarily vs 12:30.

Other Business

- Fundraising committee is working on options for an online auction.
- A member brought up having enrollment fees tied to FACTS vs requiring parents to send in a

check.

-The door to after school needs to be repaired or replaced.

-Planning on putting stewardship packets with the beginning of school year packets for all school families.
